

Clue Clarifications

Some clues might seem to have more than one interpretation. These are some spoiler free hints to help you understand the clues more clearly.

To solve the puzzle you will need to figure out where all 52 cards are.
The 4 Kings and 4 Queens are playing the game, and each player was dealt 5 cards from the remaining 44 cards.

“Deuces are Wild” means that all four 2s are wild. They can represent any card in the deck to make a better poker hand.

Every player holds a poker hand. There are two cards included with the Puzzle Deck that show all ten poker hands (from highest to lowest) that you can refer to.

In a logic puzzle, the clue “A man in a red hat” tells you that one of the men is wearing one of the red hats. The clue “The man in the red hat” tells you only one man is wearing the only red hat.

Each player is cheating in a different way. Eight different cheating techniques are shown in **bold print** within different clues. The players may think they are clever, but that doesn’t mean they are smart.

The players sit around a circular table. The eight seats are arranged like the points on a compass.
The player in the North sits West of three players and East of three players. Only one player sits directly South of them.
